Examples of eligible events:

- Wedding receptions
- Rehearsal dinners
- Bridal or baby showers
- Wedding anniversary parties
- Baptismal parties
- Quinceanera (15th Birthday) parties
- Funeral lunches (if not provided by the parish)
- Retirement parties
- Family birthday or anniversary parties
- Examples of **eligible recurring meetings**:
- Home school groups
- Community organizations
- Support groups not sponsored by the parish
- Fraternal organizations

- Homeowner association meetings
- Family reunions
- Class reunions
- Recognition dinner/party*
- Team dinners **
- Graduation parties
- Card parties*
- Fundraising dinners*

Examples of excluded events:

- Athletic events, including but not limited to free-throw contests, flag football, walkathons, 5K run/walks **
- Any activity with firearms
- Fireworks
- Motorized vehicles of any size
- Events with more than 1,000 people in attendance
- Events lasting more than 72 hours
- Inflatable devices (bouncy houses, etc.)
- *Any event that will include the sale of alcoholic beverages, either on a per-drink basis or included in the cost of admission, will require Liquor Liability coverage in addition to the Special Events Coverage.
- ** Athletic participants are not covered. Separate, additional coverage is available by application only.
