

Confirmation Dress Code

- Confirmation is a Sacrament that is celebrated with much reverence, joy, and dignity. The attire worn by both the Confirmation Candidate and his/her Sponsor should reflect the same.
- Attire during the Confirmation Mass, for both candidates and sponsors, should be Christmas or Easter best, respecting Christian modesty and Church tradition. Traditionally, this has been as follows:

What should candidates wear for Confirmation?

Women

- Dress or Skirt and Blouse

Dresses and skirts must be BELOW the knee. Dresses and blouses are to have a modest neckline; back and shoulders MUST be covered.

- Dress Shoes (*You should be able to walk comfortably*)

Men

- Navy or Black Dress Pants (*No jeans or cargo pants*)
- White Long-Sleeve Dress Shirt
- Solid Dress Tie
- Suit Jacket (*Optional*)
- Dress Socks and Dress Shoes (*No gym shoes*)

Please be sure your forehead is uncovered (free from hair or hair accessories) for anointing from the bishop.
